# UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON Information Sheet for I-LABS Registry

Do you ever wonder what your child feels, learns, or understands? We study these topics at the UW Institute for Learning and Brain Sciences (I-LABS).

We are looking for families with children (0 to 17 years old). Parents can sign up for the I-LABS Registry if they are interested. The I-LABS Registry is a confidential contact list that includes names and birthdays. Joining the I-LABS Registry is voluntary.

If you sign up, you are agreeing to let us contact you about future I-LABS studies. I-LABS researchers will contact you when your child is near an age for a study. We will tell you about our studies and see if you and your child are interested. We will also save information about your child's health and development if you provide it. We use your children's information to match them to studies. We will contact your family while your children are under 18 years old. Sometimes we may contact you about trying out studies, thanking you for helping, and asking if you want to refer a friend. At any time you can take your information out of the I-LABS Registry.

We securely store your information for future research studies. The data will be shared with staff who will contact you about child development studies. We follow UW rules for record storage. There is a risk that your information could be disclosed by a breach.

Government or university staff sometimes review studies such as this one to make sure they are being done safely and legally. If a review of this study takes place, your records may be examined. The reviewers will protect your privacy. The study records will not be used to put you at legal risk of harm.
